Their responsibilities include designing and implementing the recreational and lifestyle program that caters to the individual needs of our residents. The RAOs are assisted in their role by the Lifestyle Manager and regular training days that are attended by RAOs from all of Thompson Health Care homes, rural homes will have training days on site for convenience to staff. A Certificate IV in Lifestyle and Leisure is the preferred qualification for this role, however, we do employ unqualified staff and provide access to this course from time to time.
