Once a month we hold a High Tea in our special care unit which usually consists of warm nibbles to go with, and it is thoroughly enjoyed.



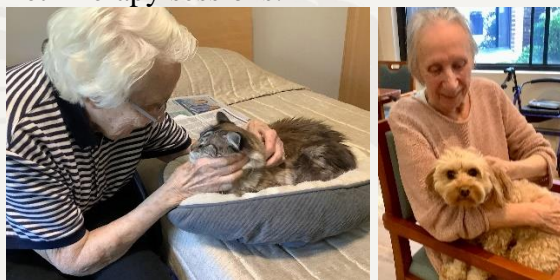
