### Multicultural Day Celebration.

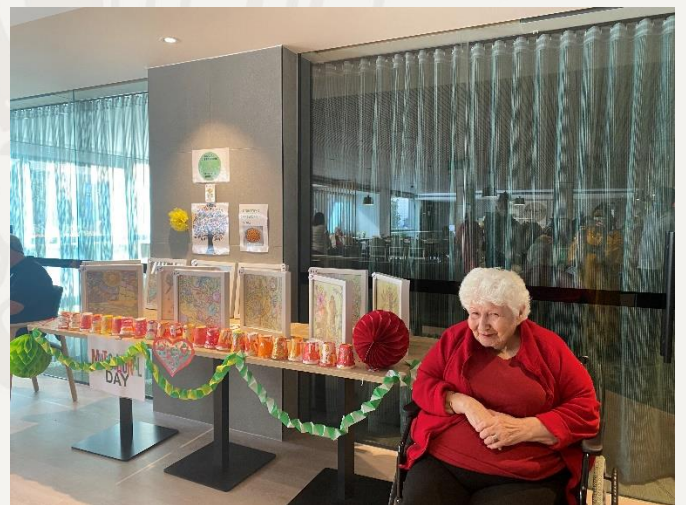

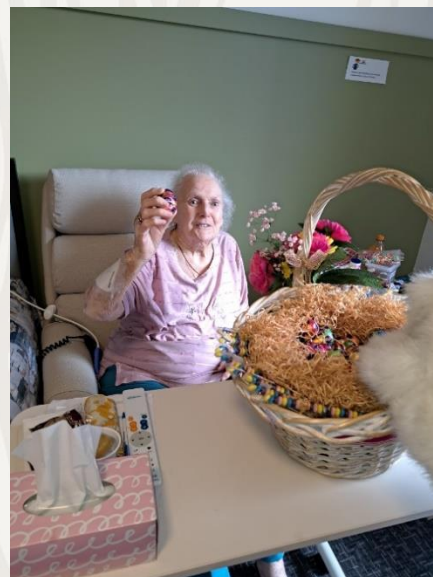




### *Easter Celebration*
