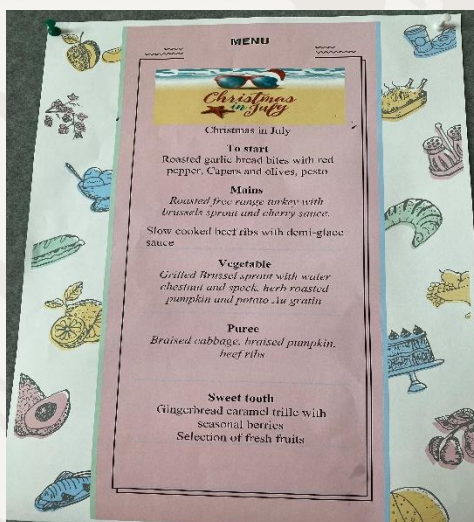


Activity 2
