Duties and Responsibilities:

- Regularly check vital signs as instructed.
- Assist in monitoring blood glucose levels frequently, ensuring they remain within the target range, administer insulin as prescribed by his doctor.
- Administer prescribed maintenance medications and diabetes management drugs as directed by his doctors, and report any adverse effects.
- Assist in meal planning and preparation that adhere to the dietary guidelines given by his RND.
- Help with daily activities such as bathing, dressing, grooming and oral care.

- Support the patient in safely getting out of the bed, walking or using mobility aids as needed.
- Assist with dressing changes and ensure the area is kept clean and dry as instructed accordingly to nursing guidelines.
- Assist and accompany patient for clinic visits, rehabilitation and physical therapy sessions, running errands such grocery, bank appointments, and travel leisure, providing transportation as needed.
- Reposition the patient to prevent bedsores.
- Prepare and administer enteral feedings via the PEG tube as per prescribed schedule.
- Respond promptly to any medical emergency or changes in the patient's status.
- Encourage independency as possible
- Assist with preparing for dialysis treatment schedules, monitor the patient during and after dialysis for complications and provide comfort.
- Regularly change bed linens and maintain clean and comfortable environment.
- Observed changes in mood or behavior, noting any signs of worsening depression, and communicate any concerns to the family and his physicians.
- Recognize seizure activity and ensure the patient in a safe position.
